Taking initiatives to minimise biodiversity impact

As a global eco-citizen, Tata Steel has through the years, taken various measures to conserve biodiversity through reclamation and afforestation of land by focussing on environmental management beyond statutory requirements.

- Mined out land at Noamundi was reclaimed to create Sir Dorabji Tata Botanical Park
- 1300 trees have been planted at Kalamati
- Sir Dorabji Tata Park at Jharia has taken shape at a reclaimed mined out area
- 1720 sq metres of Rare Plant Park has come up at Tata Steel's Noamundi mining area
- Tata Steel Zoological Park at Jamshedpur aims to protect and restore the natural habitat of local species
